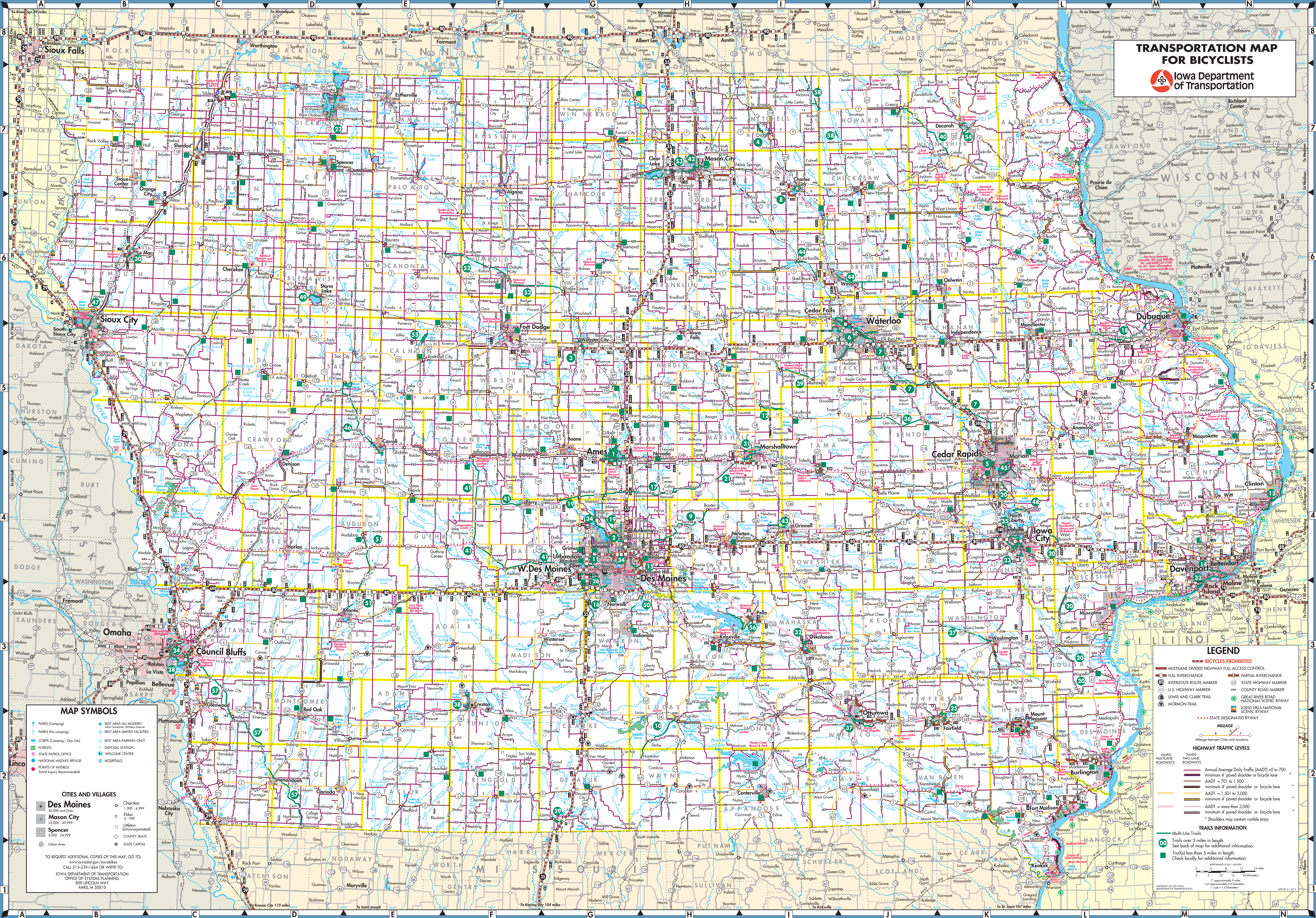


TRANSPORTATION MAP FOR BICYCLISTS

TRAIL INFORMATION

- Multi-Use Trail
- Trails over 5 miles in length. See back of map for additional information.
- Trail(s) less than 5 miles in length. Check locally for additional information.

HIWAY TRAFFIC LEVELS

- PAVED MULTILANE ROADWAYS
- PAVED TWO-LANE ROADWAYS
- Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) ≤ 700 minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane
- AADT = 701 to 1,500 minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane
- AADT = 1,501 to 3,000 minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane
- AADT = more than 3,000 minimum 4' paved shoulder or bicycle lane
- *Shoulders may contain rumble strips

MILEAGE

Aligns between Cities and Junctions

1" approximately 10 miles
1/4" approximately 2.5 miles
