

Resolution Relating to and Establishing Monthly Rates of Water
Furnished Users by the Waterworks System, Perry, Iowa

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Municipal Waterworks Plant and Systems of the City of Perry, Iowa, is by law and authorized to fix the rates to be charged users of water furnished by said plant and system and

WHEREAS, a water rate study has been conducted and the results of said study have been examined and evaluated by the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to provide rate schedules of charges for water as hereinafter set out consistent with the recommendations,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Municipal Waterworks Plant and System of the City of Perry, Iowa as follows:

Section 1. The monthly rates to be charged for water furnished by plant and system for meter readings after April 1, 2011 shall be and are as follows:

0 - 150,999 gallons	Net per thousand	3.70
Over 151,000 gallons	Net per thousand	3.35

Base Charge fee at 14.00 per month for each user on a single meter and each multiple user on a single meter

Flat Meter Charge Fee \$13.00 for multiple users (See letter May, 1985).
75% Surcharge outside city limits.

Section 2. All bills shall be rendered at the net rate. If not paid within 20 days from the billing date a penalty of 10% of the amount due shall be added to the bill.

Section 3. The Iowa sales or service tax, or any other tax imposed by upon the distribution or sale of water may be added to the foregoing rates.

Section 4. The foregoing rates do not contain any sewer rental charges that are now or may be added hereafter by the City Council of the City of Perry.

Section 5. The said Board of Trustees may from time to time, by resolution, change and readjust the foregoing rates to be charged for the water used, where it is deemed advisable in the judgement of said Board.

Section 6. Nothing contained herein shall prevent said Board of Trustees from making special contract with anyone provided that such contracts do not discriminate unfairly against anyone, and the rates therein do not exceed the foregoing.

Section 7. All resolutions and motions or parts thereof, in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent only of such conflict.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in order to save the expense of giving written notice of the new rates to all users, the Secretary be directed to publish forthwith in the Perry Chief a notice setting forth the new rates.
