Weather permitting, city crews will begin collection of clean-up items on the following schedule:

<u>SCHEDULE</u> <u>LOCATION</u>

Monday, April 18 East of 1st Street and south of Willis Ave.

Tuesday, April 19 East of 1st Street and north of Willis Ave.

Wednesday, April 20 All areas <u>west</u> of 1st Street.

Items must be placed between the curb and the property line by 7:00 a.m. to guarantee pickup. If an area is not completed on your scheduled day, then crews will complete that area the following day.

NOTE: ONCE AN AREA IS COMPLETED---CREWS WILL NOT RETURN

Crews will pick-up special phone-in requests on Thursday, April 21st, 2016.

Residents will be <u>charged a minimum amount of \$25.00</u> which will cover up to 1/2 dump truck load. Each additional 1/2 dump truck load or portion thereof will be charged an amount of \$25.00.

Small Clean-Up items must be placed in trash bags, sturdy boxes or other disposable containers no larger than a garbage can. Loose bits and pieces will not be picked up.

Items Charged Separately:

- Appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers) \$25.00 each
 Microwaves \$15.00 each. We will not accept appliances filled with food.
 Please Note: HW Recycling will hold an Appliance and Scrap Metal Collection on Saturday, June 4th,
 2016 from 8 a.m. until noon at the Perry Recycling Center. Appliances may be brought to this collection at no charge on June 4th, 2016.
- 2. Box springs, mattresses or sofas \$20.00 each

The City will not accept or dispose of the following items:

- 1. Car tires, truck and tractor tires.
- 2. Hazardous materials of any kinds.
- 3. Batteries of any kind.
- 4. Paint cans (unless empty and/or dried out).
- 5. Brush or concrete.
- 6. Metal bed springs.
