City of Perry Snow Ordinances

Vehicles: No person shall park any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street parking area during a snow emergency unless the snow has been removed with the

streets fully open and the snow has ceased to fall. A snow emergency shall be defined as any accumulation of snow in the amount of one-half inch or more.

Sidewalks: Property owners in the residential district must remove snow, ice or accumulations within forty-eight (48) hours and property owners in the business district must remove snow, ice or accumulations within twelve (12) hours from when snow, ice or accumulation ceases to fall on the sidewalks. If this does not occur, the City may perform the work and assess the costs against the property owners for collection in the same manner as property tax.

Annual Rental Property Registration & Fee

The Perry City Council passed an Ordinance that requires owners of rental properties to register all of their rental properties with the City of Perry. If you have not already registered, please register your rental properties on-line at www.perryia.org or at Perry City Hall, 1102 Willis Avenue, 3rd Floor, Perry, Iowa. The Rental Permit Fee is \$25.00 per rental unit, payable every year. Property owners will be invoiced on an annual basis. Inspections will be performed every other year on rental properties.

New Fireworks Ordinance in 2022

IT IS ILLEGAL for any person to use or explode any explosive material or consumer fireworks within Perry city limits.

The City of Perry deems the use of consumer fireworks as a threat to public safety or a nuisance to landowners and therefore prohibits the use of consumer fireworks within Perry city limits, except for commercial displays by a licensed operator that have received a permit from the City of Perry.

The penalty for violation of this ordinance is a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250). A municipal infraction of \$250 may be issued in lieu of the simple misdemeanor violation.

Animal Control in Perry

Stray and found cats and dogs in Perry are taken to the Perry Animal Control Facility and held for seven days for the owner to claim. Found animals are posted on the "City of Perry, Iowa" Facebook page. To claim an animal, owners must show proof of rabies vaccination or prepay for rabies vaccination.

After the seven day hold, unclaimed cats and dogs are taken to Raccoon River Pet Rescue to prepare the animal for adoption.
