4th of July Closings and Route Changes

Perry City Offices, the Perry Public Library, the McCreary Community Building and the Water Works Office will be closed on Tuesday, July 4th, 2023 in observance of the Independence Day holiday. Please note: MCB members age 18 and up may still use the 24-Hour Fitness Room.

The garbage route for Tuesday, July 4th will be picked up on Wednesday, July 5th.

There will be <u>NO</u> yard waste pickup on Wednesday, July 5th. Yard waste pickup will resume on July 12th with collection on the SOUTH Side of Willis Avenue.

<u>Fireworks Not Allowed in Perry City</u> Limits

IT IS ILLEGAL for any person to use or explode any explosive material or consumer fireworks within Perry city limits.

The City of Perry deems the use of consumer fireworks as a threat to public safety or a nuisance to landowners and therefore prohibits the use of consumer fireworks within Perry city limits, except for commercial displays by a licensed operator that have received a permit from the City of Perry.

The penalty for violation of this ordinance is a fine of not less than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250).

City of Perry Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off – July 15th

The City of Perry will collect household hazardous waste Saturday, July 15th from 9 a.m. until noon at the Police Station/Fire Station parking lot located at 908 Willis Items Accepted include Avenue. Antifreeze, **Batteries** (only rechargeable), Cleaners, Fertilizers, Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFLs), Glues, Gasoline and Kerosene, Motor Oil (used), Oil Filters (used), Oil Based Pesticides, Poison, Pool Paint, Chemicals, Varnishes, Roofing Tar, Mercury Thermometers, Stains, Vegetable Oil, Weed Killers and Windshield Fluid. Items Not Accepted include ammunition, asbestos, electronics, explosives, fire extinguishers, latex paint, medications, propane tanks and radioactive materials.

City of Perry Tire Drop Off – July 15th

The City of Perry will collect tires on Saturday, July 15th from 9 a.m. until noon at the Perry Garbage/Recycling Center at 14325 lvy Place. There will be no charge to dispose of the first

five car tires. A cost of \$5.00 will be charged to dispose of each additional car tire.

Park Shelter Rentals at Pattee and

Wiese Parks

Individuals are able to reserve the shelters at Pattee and Wiese Parks from April 1st to September 30th each year.

The big shelter at Pattee Park and the shelter and gazebo at Wiese Park are \$30 for a weekend reservation or \$20 per time slot during the week. The two small shelters at Pattee Park are \$20 for a weekend reservation or \$10 per time slot during the week.

Alcohol permits are available to be purchased for an extra \$25 fee with at least a 2 week notice. Photo ID is required and the applicant must be able to pass a background check. No children may be present.

There is camping available at Pattee Park for \$10.00 per night with a 5-day maximum stay (special exceptions apply). Electrical hook-ups, water, and a dump station are available, but there are no individual water hookups in the camping area.
