

Memorial Day Closings and Garbage Route Changes

Due to the Memorial Day holiday, garbage routes will be picked up as follows:

Monday, May 30th garbage route will be picked up on Tuesday, May 31st.

Tuesday, May 31st garbage route will be picked up on Wednesday, June 1st.

There will be no yard waste pickup on Wednesday, June 1st. Yard waste pickup will resume on June 8th with pickup SOUTH of Willis Avenue.

Perry City Offices, the Perry Water Works office, the Perry Public Library and the McCreary Community Building will be closed on Memorial Day. Please note: MCB members age 18 and up can still use the 24-Hour Fitness Room.

Pothole Repair List

The Public Works Department has already started a pothole repair list. To report a pothole, please call 515-465-2675. Once the asphalt

plant is open for the season, the Public Works Department will dedicate a week to repair all of the potholes. Please be patient with the crews when they are out on the streets making the repairs.

City of Perry Grass, Brush and Weed Regulations

Grass, weeds or brush may not exceed 8 inches in Residential, Business and Commercial Areas and 15 inches in Agricultural Areas. Any property within the City of Perry, whether vacated or non-vacated, with grass, weeds or brush over the limits on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month and the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month in the months of May, June, July, August, September and October, will be mowed by the City of Perry AND will be charged a fee. If payment is not received, the cost will be assessed to the property.

No Grass Clippings in the Streets/Alleys

Citizens are reminded that it is illegal to mow or place grass, leaves

and other yard waste into the public streets.

City of Perry Code of Ordinances 135.03 states "It is unlawful for any person to throw or deposit on any street or alley any ... grass, leaves, yard waste or debris ... which, if washed into the storm sewer, could clog the storm sewer. The Police Department and Public Works Department will monitor and enforce this regulation."

Besides clogging the storm sewers, grass clippings in the streets can be slick, which causes a safety hazard to motorcyclists and bicyclists.

Be a good neighbor and make certain that you don't leave clippings in the street. Use a blower and blow them back into the yard, use a broom to sweep them up, or cut in a manner that the grass gets thrown away from the street. Please call City Hall at 515-465-2481 to report any compliance issues.
