Beggars' Night and Halloween Activities

The Perry City Council has designated Friday, October 27th, 2023 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. as "Trick or Treat Night" or "Beggars' Night". Participating households should turn porch lights on.

Other Halloween Activities in Perry:

Perry Chamber of Commerce's SPOOKTACULAR Downtown Trick-or-Treat Walk is scheduled to take place on Friday, October 27th from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. in historic downtown Perry. This event includes safe trick-or-treating with local businesses and community organizations.

Dallas County Hospital's Safe and Healthy Trick or Treat event is scheduled for Friday, October 27th from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. in the North Parking Lot of the Dallas County Hospital.

Curbside Yard Waste Collection Continues

All yard waste except tree, bush or brush materials are to be placed in biodegradable paper yard waste bags with a maximum weight of forty pounds and set near the street curb in front of the residence for collection. NO GARBAGE CONTAINERS, PLASTIC BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES WILL BE ALLOWED. All tree, bush and brush materials are to be bundled and tied in

maximum lengths of four feet with a maximum weight of forty pounds and set near the street curb in front of the residence. To assure prompt pick-up, please place your yard waste at the curb by 7 a.m.

North Side of Willis Avenue:

October 4th and October 18th

South Side of Willis Avenue:

October 11th and October 25th

Fall Open Burning

A discussion was held, at the first City Council Meeting of September, on setting dates for open burning. After statements from the public and deliberation amongst council and the Mayor, a motion was made to not set any dates for 2023 fall burning and directed staff to provide educational information on the various benefits of mulching, along with continuing notices on the curbside collection and the Yard Waste Collection Site, and for a municipal infraction to remain in place violators that was unanimously by the Council. Curbside services for collection of yard waste will continue through December 06, 2023 and the Yard Waste Collection Site will remain open for residential disposal of vard-waste.

Violators of the open burning regulations will be fined \$250 for the first violation and \$500 for the second

violation!

Perry's Yard Waste Disposal Site

The City of Perry's Yard Waste Disposal Site, at 14325 Ivy Place, will remain open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily throughout the year. (The site may be closed at times due to winter weather.)

Items <u>ALLOWED</u> at the Yard Waste Disposal Site include leaves, lawn clippings, garden waste, shrubs, bushes and tree limbs not longer than 8 feet. Biodegradable paper yard waste bags may be used for disposal, but plastic bags are NOT allowed at the site. If plastic bags are used for transporting the yard waste, the bags must be emptied out and removed from the disposal site.

The Yard Waste Disposal Site is for PERRY RESIDENTS ONLY. <u>Non-resident and commercial use of the site is NOT ALLOWED.</u>

The Yard Waste Disposal Site is monitored and recorded by security cameras. Rules for use of the dump site are posted. All violators will be charged with a minimum fine of \$500 for ILLEGAL DUMPING. No warnings will be issued.
